## Travel more sustainable

### *Necessity*

Will you have to travel a far distance for work and hence produce a lot of green house gas emissions? Try to truly **consider the necessity** of going. Think about, for example, organizing an **e-conference** instead.

### *Bus and train*

If you're travelling from within **Europe**, the **good infrastructure** will allow you to choose from various modes of transport. Try to travel by **bus or by train**, for example the Eurolines going from Rotterdam to London or the flixbus to Berlin.

### *Interactive railway map*

Want to travel by train throughout Europe? Check out the '**interactive railway map**' online map, which shows the bigger European cities, to which cities they are connected and the travel time between them.

### *Compensate*

Try to **compensate** your flight, bus, or train ride by **planting trees**, for example on TreesforAll. nl

### *Airplane*

If you **can't avoid flying**, keep in mind that **direct flights** usually cause fewer green house gas emissions than stop-over flights. Therefore, choose connections **without long detours**.

### *Stay*

Try to be selective with the location(s) where you stay during your travel. Choose places with **sustainability initiatives**. Visit for example the website <https://ecobnb.com/> for inspiration.
